

SIGNS IT'S TIME TO SCHEDULE PAVING WORK



- Cracks are spreading or forming large, interconnected patterns
- Potholes or surface breakouts are appearing
- Water is pooling or drainage is poor
- Pavement surface is faded, brittle, or heavily worn
- Uneven areas or depressions are developing
- Sections feel soft or are sinking under traffic
- Edges are crumbling or breaking away
- Previous repairs are failing or recurring
- Pavement is 15–25+ years old without major work
- Maintenance costs are increasing year over year



WHEN TO SCHEDULE PAVING WORK

- Plan between spring and fall for the best results.
- Aim for dry weather to help your pavement last longer.
- Schedule before busy seasons to avoid disruptions.
